

# **Judge Clears Student Of 2 Charges**

The president of the Black Students Union at the University of Buffalo was found innocent Tuesday in Buffalo City Court of two charges stemming from an incident with campus security officers Oct. 25.

Judge H. Buswell Roberts acquitted Larrone B. Williams, 21, of Rodney St., of harassment and resisting arrest charges placed against him after he was stopped in Lisbon Ave.

Asst. Dist. Atty. Marvin S. Greenfield charged that Williams became abusive and attacked the security officers after they asked him for his drivers' license.

Judge Roberts ruled after a nonjury trial that it was unlikely that Williams would strike the first blow in the presence of two security officers at the scene.

The arrest came during a week marked by confrontation between the Black Students Union and the university over tardy scholarship checks to disadvantaged students.
