

1/2	<b>Irate Crowd Breaks Into Dance at UB</b>		<i>Black Student Union</i>
1 1/2	Seven windows and a door were broken and the basement was flooded in Clark Hall on the University of Buffalo Main St. <del>Campus on Friday night</del> when hundreds of patrons barged into a sold-out dance hall.		
2	A UB spokesman said hundreds of patrons became outraged when the hall was closed after reaching its capacity of 1,800 persons about 9 p.m. The spokesman said persons outside the hall began pushing and shoving to enter. The windows were broken and a water fountain on the second floor in the building was knocked from its foundation, causing water to run down stairways, and flood the basement to a depth of four inches.

4	The spokesman said campus security police stood by and no arrests were made. He said the disturbance ended without police action after the crowd burst into the hall. The crowd broke one door off its hinges.		
4 1/2	The disturbance lasted about a half hour.		
	<b>No Damage Estimate</b>		
5 1/2	No estimate of damage was made.		
6	The spokesman said the crowd in the hall swelled to an estimated 2,800 — 1,00 more than capacity. "They were jammed pack — sitting and standing everywhere," he added.		
6 1/2	He also said scores of automobiles were parked illegally on campus sidewalks and lawns.		
7	The dance was sponsored by the University Activity Board and the Black Student Union, and was scheduled to end shortly after midnight.
