½	Blast UB		
1	Concert Plan		
1½	A concert to be sponsored by a University of Buffalo student group at the Buffalo Theater next Sunday night has struck a sour note in the minds of members of UB's minority groups at whom the performance is aimed.		
2	Spokesman for the Black and Puerto Rican Student Unions and the International Student Organization say they will picket the theater before the show begins at 8:30 p.m.		
3	The principal objection to the performance, according to Edward Guity, coordinator of minority affairs for the State Student Assn., is that minority students were not involved in the planning.		
4	Racial Objection		
4½	Another objection, Guity said is that of the three principal performers, only one is black, although the show is aimed at a largely black audience.		
5½	The black performer, he said, is Norman Connors, a "soul music" singer. Other performers on the bill are Vicky Sue Robinson, also a singer, and David Sanborn and his band.		
6	Jeff Lessoff, director of the University Union Activities Board (UUAB) which is sponsoring the concert, claimed that although Sanborn is white, members of his band are black. He said Miss Robinson is a mulatto.		
6½	"It's ridiculous to think that this is not a minority concert," he said. "All these groups have hit records on the rhythm and blues charts."		
7	Lessoff said that generally buyers of records in that chart are black.		
7½	Few Blacks on Panel		
8	He said the music committee which, picked the groups is open to all students, but that few blacks became involved.		
8½	Lessoff said the decision to schedule the concert in the downtown Buffalo Theater rather than on the campus was because \$1,800 damage was done to Clark Gymnasium when a concert for minorities was held there last year.
