

½	<b>Damage Is Put at \$350 In Wake of UB Uproar</b> Damage was placed at around \$350 Saturday in the wake of a disturbance the previous night at the <u>University of Buffalo Main St.</u> campus during a student dance. A surging crowd of about 1,000 students broke seven windows, tore the latch out of a door and ripped a water fountain from a wall in Clark Hall when they were denied admission to a dance because the dance hall was already filled to capacity.	UB spokesman James R. DeSantis said the two student organizations which sponsored the dance, the Black Student Union and the University Activity Board, have liability insurance that will cover the damage costs.	DeSantis said he doubted any disciplinary action will be taken in connection with the incident, stating.
