"General Cemetery for the Interment of the Dead in the Neighbourhood of the
"Metropolis," We, The General Cemetery Company, incorporated by and
under the said Act, in consideration of the sum of Three Pounds
and three shillings
to us in hand paid by Frederick Mew of 30 Doughty
Street Bedford Row in the county of
Middlesex Esquire



do hereby grant and convey unto the said Frederick Mew

the exclusive right of burial and interment
Grave six feet and six inches long
by Two feet and Six inches wide, situate and being in
the consecrated part of All Souls' Cemetery, at KENSAL GREEN, in the parish of
KENSINGTON, in the County of Middlesex, distinguished by the Number 25432
To hold the same to the said Frederick Mew

in perpetuity, for the purpose of burial and of erecting or
placing thereon, subject to the approval of the Company, a Monument in stone, Provided
that such Monument shall be so erected or placed within six calendar months from the
date hereof (unless licence for further time be obtained from the said Company), such
Grave and Monument, with the appurtenances, to be so erected or
placed, and from time to time kept in repair by the owner or owners for the time being, and
to be subject to such rules, orders, and regulations, as have been or shall from time to time
hereafter be made by the said Company for the management and regulation of the said
Cemetery, and the Vaults, Graves, and Monuments therein, or this Grant shall be void.

day of March one thousand eight hundred and seventy six
